## Opportunities to Reach, Teach & Serve

### PORK TENT REPORT

Today we welcome, Sara Ford, a representative from the Indiana Pork Producers here to present the pork tent check. This was our 6<sup>th</sup> year to be blessed with this opportunity to serve. We had 161 individuals signed up for at least one shift, 41 of those worked at least 2 shifts. 30 people worked who had never signed up in the previous 5 years. Here is the breakdown of the shifts: 51 "all day", 78 "afternoon" and 91 "morning" for a total of 220 shifts worked. 10% of the check will go to the food pantry ministry and the other 90% will go toward the church debt. Thanks to all those who participated. Until next year, "think pork."
