GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

Tina Isenhower missionary to Haiti with Damou Christian Mission and one of our "living link" supported missions. Tina is a graduate of Hamilton Heights and her parents still reside in Arcadia. Our website recounts her ordeal of being in Port-au-Prince during the earthquake took place and searching for her parents who had arrived that morning. They were reunited and were finally able to fly from Port-au-Prince to Jacmel, where she lives and ministers in a small village outside the town. Although there was less damage there, they are still feeling huge tremors. They have received 4 truckloads of food and plan to feed 3,200. The cost of feeding those is estimated at \$7,000 a month. They are anticipating the arrival of 12-15 orphans. Her prayer requests: pray for the children who lost parents, pray God will guide us in helping the neediest children, pray for wisdom for us in choosing children who need help and pray God will provide the needed funds to help. You may give toward earthquake relief through your offering by designating one of two missions we support: Damou, or IDES (International Disaster Emergency Services).
