VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Can You Serve Just ONE Wednesday This Fall? Commit to cook, serve, and clean up just one meal for *The Summit* fall session. You can choose the menu. We would like to provide a meal but do not have a permanent kitchen team in place. If you can provide small group of people and accept this challenge, please contact the church office. You'll shop and prepare to feed about 100, and the church supplies the funds (which come from donations – so no steak!) We can even supply menu ideas!

Serve...at the Indiana State Fair Pork Tent for several years we have provided volunteers to work at the Pork Tent at the Indiana Stare Fair and have received \$10,000 of which \$9,000 goes on the church debt and \$1,000 to missions. We must provide 12 volunteers (age 14 and up) each day for 12 days (August 5-15, 21-22). You may serve a full day shift, only morning or afternoon and multiple times. You will receive entrance to the fair, cap, apron, and *free pork tent food*. Sign up in the south hallway.
