**1 Corinthians 3:12-14**

<sup>12</sup> If any man builds on this foundation using gold, silver, costly stones, wood, hay or straw, <sup>13</sup> his work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each man's work.

<sup>14</sup> If what he has built survives, he will receive his reward. <sup>15</sup> If it is burned up, he will suffer loss; he himself will be saved, but only as one escaping through the flames.

**Big Idea**

**Big Idea – Live Your Life to Leave a Legacy**

- The Big Idea brings us to the final question we must ponder upon: What am I leaving behind? Money, cars, houses, bills...Memories. You are leaving a legacy behind even at this very moment. Your actions, words, and lifestyle will impact the next generation but will it be the legacy that God will be proud of?

**Big Question – If you knew you had one month to live,

**Three Key Elements in Building a Godly Legacy**

**Element #1 – Conviction**

- **Isa. 40:8 (NIV)**
- **Matt. 7:26 (The Msg)**
- **Key Point** – We are reminded that we are called to live by faith and not by sight. Living by faith means that I live with the great conviction of bringing glory to the Lord with every breath I take because I am living for an eternal reward not a temporal reward.

## Element #2 – Character

- **Rom. 8:29 (The Msg)**
- **Key Point** – Every Christian is called to be a man or woman of integrity based not off of a worldly definition of character and integrity but based upon God’s standard of righteousness for His people.

## God’s Character Building Tools

- Problems
- Pressures
- People

## Element #3 – Community

- **Luke 10:40-42**
- **Key Point** – The final point brings us to the understanding that God created us to live in community with Him and with others thus we are called to love God and Love Others in Mt. 22:37-40. The greatest legacy that we can leave is teaching people to love unconditionally by our words and example.

1. What is God calling you to do for His glory? What is your calling? What is stopping you from pursuing that calling?
